- 15, 25, 50, 62 & 100-miles loops to choose from.
- Rest and food stops on every loop.
- All loops include the famous Amish schoolhouse; one piece of pie or 2 cookies per cyclist.
- Cyclist number or wrist bands must be shown at rest stops.
- After tour party on Legislative Mall with live band and catered BBQ picnic. Extra meals can be purchased.
