

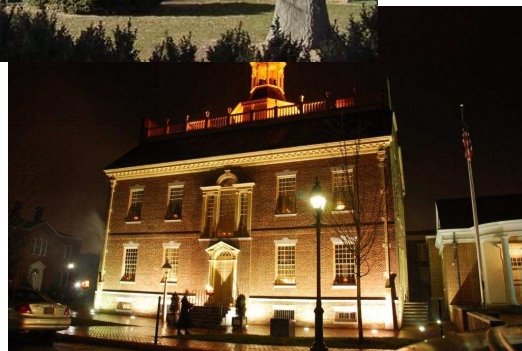
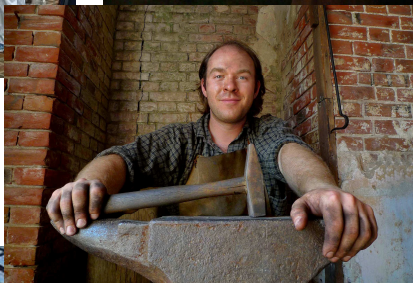

First State Heritage Park

- Welcome Center open seven days a week featuring literature and rotating exhibits; currently featuring *USS Delaware* and Delaware Soldiers in the Civil War
- Several specialized tours guided by period dress interpreters
- John Dickinson (penman of the American Revolution's boyhood home) Plantation tours and hands-on activities
- The Old State House and today's Legislative Hall, a contrast of Delaware's political history
- *New!* Visit the John Bell House on The Green. Recently restored and may be one of the oldest surviving workshops in the country. Period dress interpreters will lead the tours
- Woodburn, home of the Delaware Governor, guided tours
- Biggs Museum of American Art, collection of Delaware Valley art and antiques
